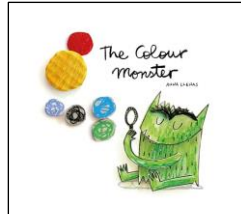
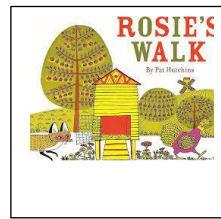


Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Naming emotions.



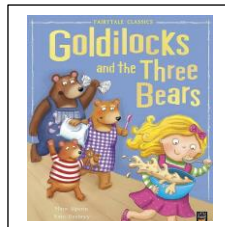
Mathematics

Physical Development
