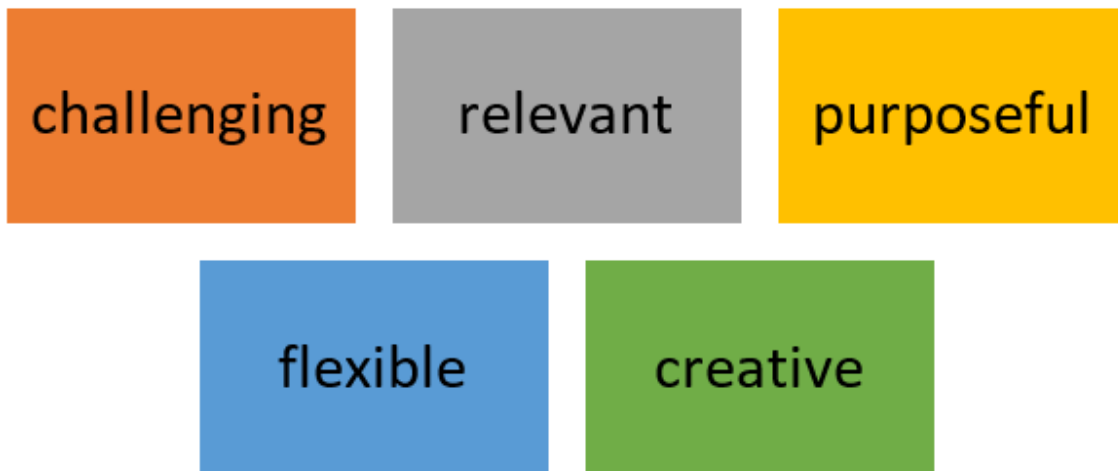


CURRICULUM INTENT

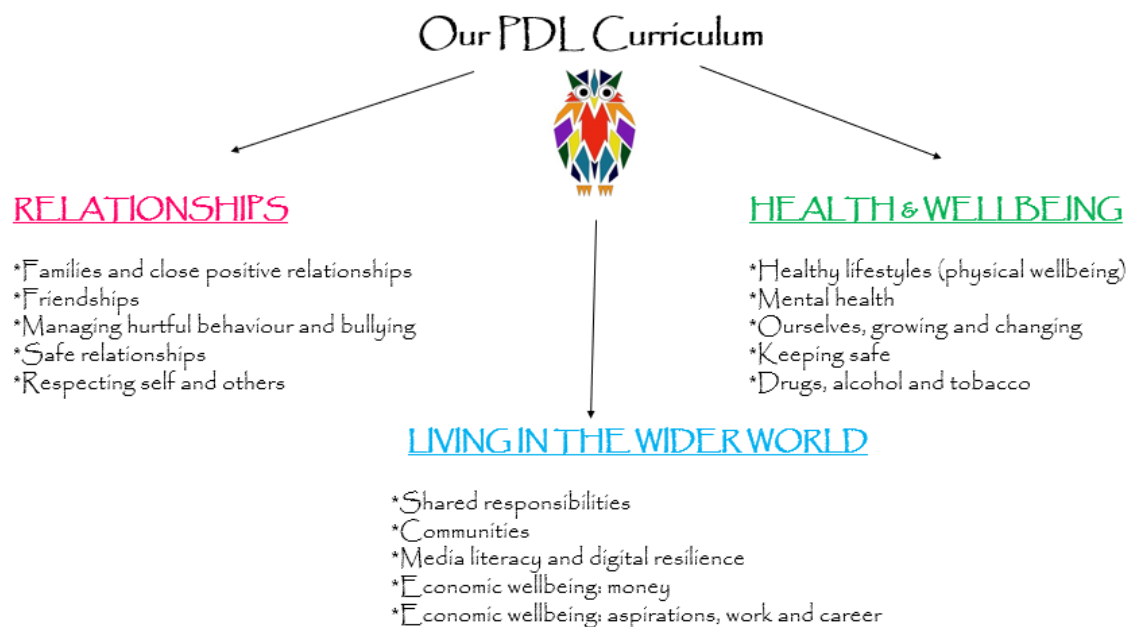
