School Drawstring bags- is this a viable option from September. Parent reps feel that unless they were personalized it would be really hard for children to identify their bag.

There would be a cost implication for parents. Safety of things in the bag would be an issue e.g., bottle / books would get damaged as the drawstring bags provide no protection.



Uniform- developing a step-by-step guide for parents to be aware of the process when a child consistently does not wear school uniform. Parent reps shared the knock-on effect on others when children don't wear the correct uniform. It causes other children to question and argue against wearing uniform. It is felt that there are more children not following expectations on uniform for PE and Forest School than the daily uniform.

Communication ideas for sharing information to the CT at the start of the day. Is there a way to add messages to Arbor?

Possible communication book was discussed, but parent reps felt that this would be a lot of work and most parents don't have time to write in a book in the morning.
