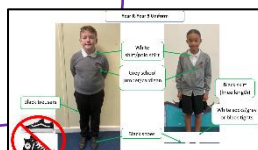

Update
On....

- Updates continue to be chased, but further improvements are very reliant on the local council.
- The school has received a bronze award for travel planning and continues to strive for further improvements.
- Parents raised that there was no crossing patrol lady last week.
- Plans being explored to offer Bikeability to a broader age range of children.
- A clear stance on uniform with the new school year has proven very successful so far.
- A flow chart has been created for staff on stages of response when children aren't wearing uniform. This will support consistency in response.
- School have also developed a step-by-step guide for parents to be aware of the process when a child consistently does not wear school uniform
- A black hoodie with a logo is being explored for children to be able to wear for PE and Forest School.



- Clarity of messages and different platforms in use is meaning some parents feel they are missing some messages.
- Human error risk around first aid slips continue to be a factor in the sharing of information.
- Facebook pages have become more aligned now with clear roles.
- Clubs – information on Arbor is not always clear about what the club is or when and for how long it is running. Some clubs were down to start at 3:30pm making parents feel they had to come up to school for 15 minutes.
- All current Reps are happy to continue as Reps, but agree it would be good to get new people joining for some fresh ideas and thoughts.

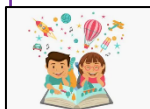

- Query around pre booking lunches- this is a request from Dolce. Pre-booked orders are locked in, those that are not ore-booked teachers check with each child to ensure that all children receive a meal at lunchtime.
- Entrance to the school playground at the start and the end of the school day is a bottleneck. School has liaised with the accessibility team and they have stated that the paths are compliant. Plans in process for a connecting path between the two playgrounds.

Actions

- Communication strategy being explored around using Arbor as the main system.
- The school are looking at investing in an online app e.g., Medi-tracker, to report any first aid incidents. This will be started in October.
- HT and school office to liaise around how the information about clubs is being shared.
- HT to send out an invitation for other parents to join the parent forum. This will include key aspects that parent forum has helped to influence e.g., uniform, communication, Facebook groups etc.
