Welcome to the Autumn Term of Year 4

Dear Parents,

We have had a great start to the term in Year four, where the children have been getting used to being back in school and have already started to learn about our history topic, the Anglo-Saxons. We have lots of exciting learning planned for the term and we cannot wait to get started – please take a look at the curriculum overview that has been sent out with this letter for more information on what we are covering and our key concepts for the term.

The start and the end of the day

Our school day starts at 8.35am and ends at 3.15pm. Please bear with us as we are seeing children out as we need to release them one at a time as we see parents and carers. Please make sure that all names are on the collection list, if you wish to add a person please speak to a member of the office staff.

What to bring to school

All children should have a water bottle in school every day – they will be in charge of filling and refreshing these during the day and will bring them home to be washed. These should be in addition to the drink they bring for lunch. They do not need to bring a pencil case, any toys or notebooks from home.

PE days

Year 4 PE days will be Thursday and Friday every week. Please ensure that on PE days your child wears trainers, black shorts or jogging bottoms and a white t-shirt. In cold weather your child should also wear a plain black hoodie or school jumper. Also, year 4 will be going swimming on Wednesdays after October half term for six weeks. Please look out for a letter coming soon but, in the meantime, please help your child prepare by making sure they can dress and dry themselves after baths independently.

Forest School

In Year 4 the classes will rotate accessing Forest School sessions on a Wednesday afternoon. We ask that for Forest School sessions children wear long sleeves and trousers and appropriate footwear, such as boots or wellies. When it is your child's day for Forest School please send them to school in their Forest School clothes, with a spare change of clothes (does not have to be their uniform) in their bag in case they get wet or dirty.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

In June 2026, year 4 pupils will undertake the national Multiplication Tables Check which assesses children on tables up to 12 x 12. Learning their multiplication tables will really assist your child





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with the maths that they will encounter in Upper Key Stage 2 involving calculating with fractions and percentages.

Children will be practicing their tables in school, but it would be great if you could encourage your child to also practice these at home too. Children can access games via their Purple Mash log in and also use Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) and www.timestables.co.uk. Log-ins will be sent out soon.

Healthy snack and lunchboxes

Children need to bring in a healthy snack, for example: fruit, crackers and nut-free cereal bars for breaktime. Please can those bringing a packed lunch from home ensure there is a healthy balance of food and a separate drink.

We find children are more able to concentrate on their learning when they have a healthy diet and are hydrated throughout the day. Please also do not send your child to school with sweets or fizzy drinks in their lunch boxes. Some ideas can be found here

Reading expectations

The expectation for reading is that children read every day with an adult at home, we recommend about 10 to 15 minutes with a short chat at the end about what they have read, and for this to be recorded in their reading log. Children will be awarded dojos for reading and those who read at least three times in the week will have a chance of selecting a new book during Owlets assembly.

How you can help your child in Year 4

Encourage your child to be responsible for their own belongings, eg. bringing in their reading record daily.

Take your child to the town library and choose different types of books to read.

Practise multiplication tables together.

Play games such as Monopoly, Chess, Blokus, Dobble and Scrabble with your child, or role-play going to the shops with real money to support their learning in Maths and English.

Spend time cooking with your child to practise reading and following instructions and understanding weights and measures.

Visit local museums to explore the past so they can make to the historical eras being covered in school.

Take them swimming.
