Whatever your plans are for the summer, I hope that you have a relaxing and enjoyable time.

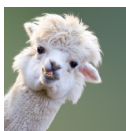

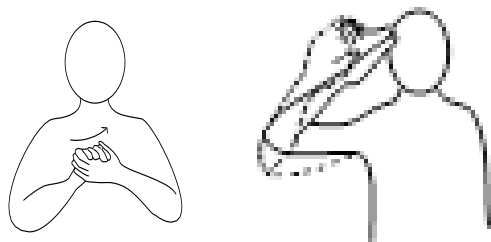
